Most of the time is spent training 'on the job' with BGES, but there is also time spent at college for theory and practical study. Here's what they had to say...

For new apprentice **Tom**, the 'on the job' aspect of an apprenticeship is very appealing. "I was keen to start work as soon as I'd finished school, so, I applied to BGES Group just after I'd finished my studies.
